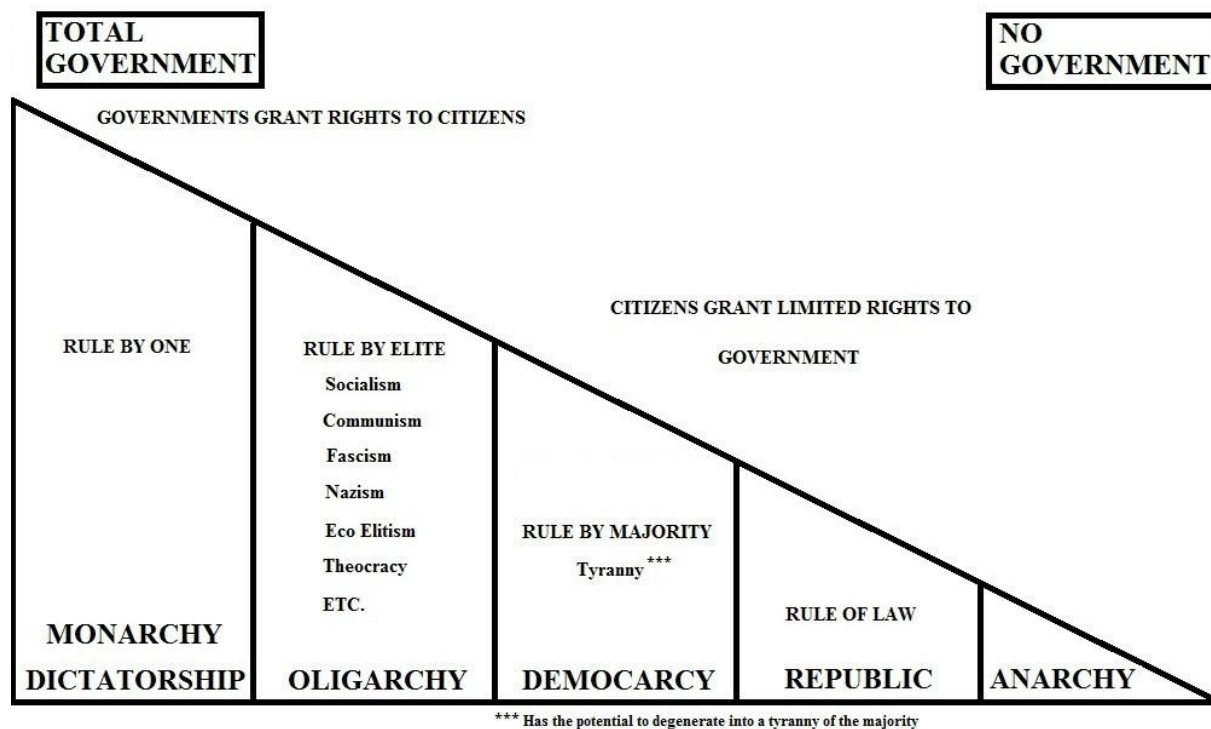


The Far Right and the Far Wrong

Are You on the Far Right?

The terms "left" and "right" to describe a person's political leanings apparently originated in the German Reichstag during the 1930s when the Nazis occupied the right side of the chamber while the Communists occupied the left side.

Today, the term "far right" is generally applied to anyone who has the temerity to challenge leftist dogma and implies that the person subscribes to fascist doctrines, especially those of the National Socialists of Germany, the Nazi Party. Also, the term "far right" is frequently used by leftists to insinuate that all who are any ideological distance to the right of them on the political spectrum are morally bankrupt, and in that respect are indistinguishable from each other.

What are characteristics of the "left" and "right" segments of the political spectrum? To answer this question, it is necessary to examine the political spectrum as defined by the size of the government bureaucracy.

It is generally understood that socialists occupy the left side of the political spectrum. However, few are willing to recognize that fascists and communists are also members of the big-government or left side of the political spectrum. Anarchies are on the "far right" while republics and democracies are on the right side of the political spectrum.

Furthermore, it must be emphasized that socialism is the first rung on a big-government ladder. This ladder may lead a society up to fascism, communism, and eventually to the World Economic Forum's global tyranny ("New World Order") where "you will own nothing and you will be happy".

Socialists, fascists, and communists inevitably create "big governments" with ties to big industry, or governments having complete ownership of the means of wealth production, all of which is an anathema to conservatives.

Contrary to Marx-inspired socialist/fascist/communist dogma, conservatives exalt the individual and loathe big government and accompanying high taxes and loss of freedom.

Needless to say, conservatives reject the big-government ladder while socialists are more likely to move up this ladder and embrace elements of the fascist and communist doctrines, even to the extent of using disingenuous tactics (e.g. DEI, ESG, CRT, cancel culture) to peddle their dogma.

In other words, it is absurd to accuse a conservative of being a fascist when they reject all dogma associated with the left or big-government side of the political spectrum.

Accusing a person of being "far right" is the last refuge of scoundrels who attempt to defend the indefensible. Such scoundrels are most often projecting their own behaviors and political goals. The drivers of lefty dogma are aware of the hypocrisy, but the supporting false accusations are propagated often unknowingly by their trusting and naive salesmen in the fields of media and education.

According to Winston Churchill, "socialism is the philosophy of failure, the creed of ignorance, and the gospel of envy. Its inherent virtue is the equal sharing of misery."

The risk of a leftist dictatorship governing a country is minimized with an honest, competent, independent media and an education system that embraces critical thinking and rejects indoctrination of Marx-inspired narratives and ideologies.

Furthermore, the integrity of the voting system is paramount in defending the democratic system of government. In other words, the ballot box must not be compromised by tactics such as: the massive mail-out of ballots, mail-in ballots, lack of signature verification, unsupervised ballot drop boxes, ballot curing, ballot harvesting, ballot messengers, programmable voting machines, lack of voter ID, extended voting periods, the violation of voting regulations, and a judicial system unwilling to challenge obvious election fraud.
