Over immediate opponent's t/o double of partner's weak two bid

- New suit is lead directing with a fit
- Redouble
 - one has a suit to run to as it looks like the double will be passed for penalty. If the doubler is short in the suit, as he should be, and you are short, the double will likely be passed for penalty.
 - relay
 - Asks partner to bid next step if intervening opponent does not bid
 - The redoubler will pass or correct
- 2NT = Ogust
- Pass could be a penalty pass.

Examples

W	N	E	S
2♥	Dbl	3♣	

East wants a club lead so he can lead ♥'s if South bids 3NT.

W	N	E	S
2♥	Dbl	Rdbl	P
2♠	P	3♣	

North and East are short in ♥'s
East has a better place to play in ♣'s

W	N	E	S
2♥	Dbl	Rdbl	2♠
P			

Over 3 Preempts

3♦ Dbl Rdbl

The standard way is the redouble shows that we double the opponents where ever they end up. It gives the preempter permission to double if the holding dictates it.

However, it can be SOS (with a suit to run to) asking partner to bid the next step up if they pass for penalties.
