## Five-Five or Longer

When Partner Opens 1NT, Stayman is used with five-five in the majors or longer with an invitational hand or better. It is on after partner responds 2♦ to Stayman.

1NT	2♣	
2♦	3♦	5-5 in the majors or better, invitational
3NT		2-2 in majors, maximum (Super Texas?)
3M		major fit, minimum
4M		major fit, maximum

If responder is six-five or six-six, he can bid the six-card suit (naturally or through Super Texas if Super Texas is written on the cc) after a 3NT response to 3♦.

## Five-Four

With five-four, Stayman is also used with Smolen as game forcing at the three-level only.

1NT	2♣	
2♦	2♥	5♥s, 4♠s, 8-9
	2♠	5♠s, 4♥s, 8-9
	3♥	5♠s, 4♥s, 10+, GF
	3♠	5♥s, 4♠s, 10+, GF

With five-four and a weak hand (0-7), responder transfers to the five-card suit and passes.

## Six-Four

1NT 2♣  
2♦ 4♦ Texas (Super Texas) to 4♥, 6♥s, 4♠s  
4♥ Texas (Super Texas) to 4♠, 6♠s, 4♥s  
4♥, 4♠ are natural if Super Texas not on cc.
