1NT 3♣ or 3♦ shows:

a six card suit 6-8 HCP

some need 2 of top 3 honours

I impose no such restriction except count unsupported Jacks as 0 HCP's.

with 9+ bid 3NT

with 0-5 consider MST

MST is never done with 6+ points and rarely done with 5.

Partner will go to 3NT with Hxx (honour third or longer) otherwise will pass and allow partner to play in the minor.
